20/21 – 0603 Minutes of Previous meeting

- a) The minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on Monday 4th May 2020 were reviewed and agreed as an accurate and true record and signed accordingly.

20/21 – 0604 Update from Ward Councillors

- a) Cllr Waltham gave an update stating that brown bin collections would resume this week, however, so far, 250 people had opted to give up their brown bin in favour of a compost bin under the ‘Grow not Throw’ initiative.
Shops were beginning to re-open with support from NLC and accreditation for risk assessments prior to opening. Brigg Market would resume on Thursday 4th June 2020. Cllr Waltham updated that NLC had taken on further responsibilities for local lockdowns should they be required.
The devolution of verge and PROW cutting to Parish Councils had proved popular with many Parish Councils taking up the opportunity.
Cllr Waltham updated that the AONB bid would be going in on 15th June 2020.
Cllr Waltham cited that issues around Carr Lane had been taken on board, but there was no further update at this time.

20/21 – 0605 Community COVID-19 Support & Clerk’s Report

- a) The Clerk updated on the progress of the community support group, and recently set up Facebook page, stating that the Community was engaging well with the page.
The Clerk highlighted the residents request for a festival on the playing field as a celebration at the end of lockdown. Councillors discussed that they would be very happy to support an event of this kind.
- b) Clerk updated the Parish Council that the recent Bioganix planning application PA/2020/540 - Planning application to vary condition 6 of PA/2005/0736 to allow for operations to take place 24 hours a day, every day) had been withdrawn.
The Clerk had received a complaint regarding a willow tree with very low branches overhanging pavement at 18 Main Street, a large conifer hedge obstructing pavement at 4 Main Street and a large hedge obstructing pavement opposite 4 Main street (last hedge as

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you are leaving the village on right hand side heading towards Worlaby), which had been reported to NLC for action.
